Today's Scripture:

“And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him and let it drop (leave it, let it go), in order that your Father Who is in heaven may also forgive you...”

(Mark 11: 25 AMP)

A Prayer for Today:

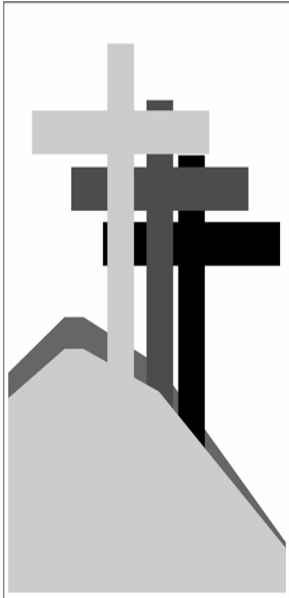
